SIDESHEETS are	basic tools for writers (and other creators) during creative process:		
□ to cu	to cultivate openness, curiosity, spontaneity and nonjudgment		
□ to red	to record ideas, images, symbols and sensations		
SIDESHEETS can	be used spontaneously for quicksilver creativity or routinely:		
□ to generate fresh writing (or other expressive forms)			
□ for ol	for observational or responsive note-taking		
□ to aid	to aid reading/rereading* of one's writing or another's		
□ with choice of colour(s) and in any chosen fashion			
They include:			
SIDESHEET	#1 Open space for uncensored free writing or brainstorming an idea, image, symbol, sensation		
SIDESHEET	#2 Dialogue space for two characters, concepts, contrasts or pairs of words, images, symbols, sensations or any combo		
SIDESHEET	#3 Juxtaposition of three, e.g., genres of writing, themes or any combo of options above		
SIDESHEET	#4 Cluster around one to four elements from options above, whether interrelated or not		

How to proceed: Preplan or spontaneously choose any **SIDE**SHEET(S) as your creativity unfolds. They provide a record of your process, with date in grey blank.
